CONTROVERSIES IN NEURO-ONCOLOGY

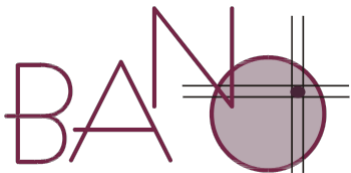
Everybody involved in the care of neuro-oncology patients, is being confronted with challenging questions.
